

Teviot Wind Farm

Site Context

Site Location

The Teviot Wind Farm site is located approximately 8km to the south-west of Hawick in the Scottish Borders, as shown in **Figure 1**. The site is located to the east of the A7 road and Teviothead. The topography of the site comprises a series of hills and ridges rising to around 600m including the centrally located Skelfhill Pen and Greatmoor Hill, Cauldcleugh Head in the south-east and The Pike in the north-east.

The current land use is hilltop sheep farming with large areas of commercial forestry. There are a number of residential properties along the A7/Teviot Valley to the north of the site, as well as some properties to the north-east around Skelfhill.

The closest operational wind farm is Langhope Rig, located approximately 13.5km to the north-west of the site. Our Crossdykes Wind Farm and the Craig, and Ewe Hill Wind Farms are located approximately 20km to the south-west.
